U.S. Travel Advisory for Tourist Destinations in Mexico Remains the Same

Contrary to recent media coverage, the U.S. State Department Travel Advisory has not changed for major international tourist destinations in Mexico, including Cancún, Cozumel, Playa del Carmen, Tulum, Riviera Maya, and Isla Mujeres.

The current U.S. Travel Advisory continues to rank major tourist areas of Mexico with the same classification as other common destinations for American travel, including England, Denmark, Belgium and Germany.

There was a portion of the travel advisory updated earlier this week regarding the ability of government personnel to travel to and from downtown Ciudad Juarez, a border city more than 2,000-miles from Cancun. This is not an area frequented by tourists.

According to the Mexico Tourism Board, 94 percent of all U.S. tourists reported that their trip to Mexico exceeded expectations and 86 percent said they would like to come back again in the next six months ([source](#)).
